A few persons of a society know them in their lives but after their death, they become famous. They are called Civic Society of a country and their organizational name are NGOs. US State Department have done a good job Inviting them in their country to make them visible from invisible. Thanks to all concerned of State Department for the invitation on behalf of all participants.

I have a few experience of helping the poor young men & women one of which is cited bellow. My organization '**New Generation Humanitarian Organization**' which is duly approved by the government of Bangladesh as an NGO started a computer operating course only to make some word processors aiming self employment in December, 2015. It was a '5-week' course with 10 Computers and two instructors. Our total expenditure was 10.2 thousand U.S dollar only but 1000(one thousand) educated and non-edu- cated young people were trained after one year. To follow up the training result, we found that all trained persons got a work either in office or self-em-

ployed worker. It is a news of happiness but all the expenditure of the project was domestic donation.

It is very painful to us because of collection of domestic donation is very tough. But it has been encouraged us to take a greater project if we get a few sum of foreign donation i.e. if we get 1(one) million U.S. dollar we will be able to train up at a time 10,000 (ten thousand) young people per year.

We need 90% and above word processors and 5-10% programmer or other higher technician only.

Government of Bangladesh has emphasized on Computer Technology as well as IT Sector to cope with other developed countries. So, as a highly technical and IT based country like U.S.A. export-import business is improving day by day both in our government and private sector. So, the entrepreneurs and business-men will be benefited by the trade in this sector. Therefore, they can easily donate our NGO/NGOs who are working in this sector without any hesitation. As a representative of an NGO like Computer and IT Sector I invite all U.S. business-men of this Sector and donors also to donate something either in related things or in money as you prefer to the NGO/NGOs so that we can enter into the modern world rapidly. If we stand for once we never fall. I want to remember the organizer, 'Sense of modernization begins from civic society first.' It is true that Leadership

comes from democratic atmosphere of a country, sometimes Its opposite may be true i.e. democra- cy comes by the leadership of civic society. It depends upon how civic society controls the soci- ety.
